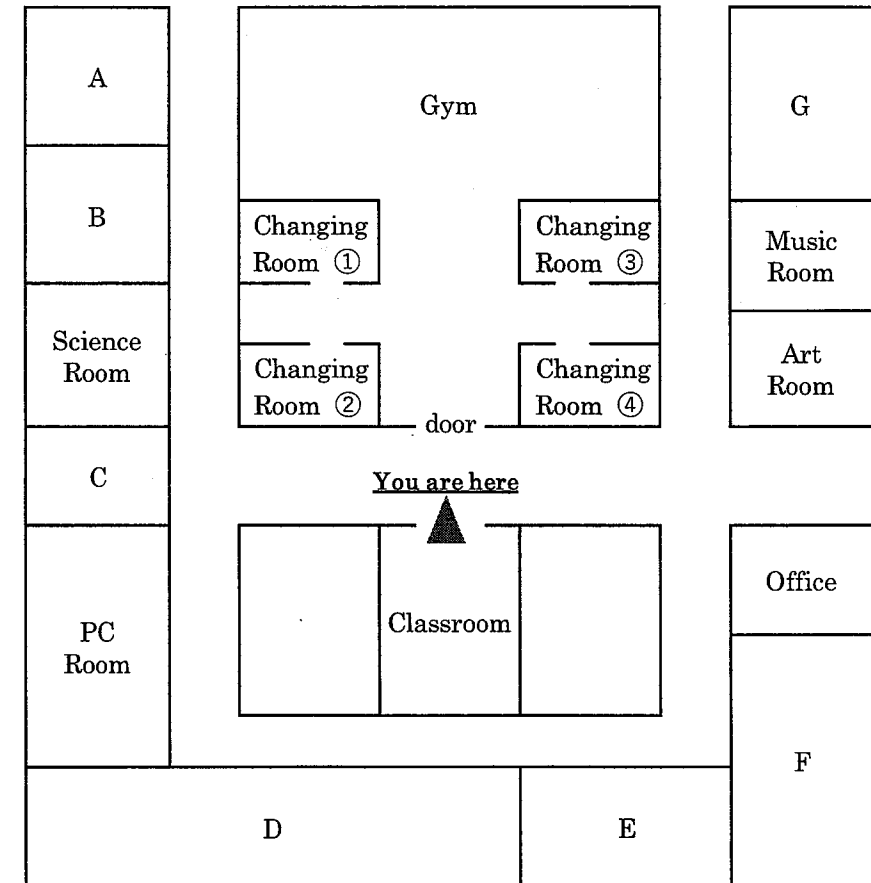

【6】次の文は、プラスチックゴミ(plastic waste) について高校生の Aya が行った発表です。
これを読んで、あとの問いに答えなさい。

Today, I will talk about the problem of plastic waste in the world.

Plastics are *polluting the *environment because they are not *natural materials. Natural materials such as wood and plants are easy to *break down, but plastics such as plastic bottles and plastic bags are not: once they are made, they'll continue to (A) on earth for hundreds of years. Most of them become plastic waste. You can see plastic waste in many places. For example, in the ocean, many sea animals living there eat it by mistake. *As a result, about 100,000 sea animals are killed every year. The ocean is not a (B) place for them now.

《ア》 That is “*microplastics.” Microplastics come from larger plastics. Sunlight and ocean *waves break plastics into smaller pieces. When they become smaller than five *millimeters, they are called “microplastics.” We can't see some of them without a *microscope. 《イ》 Some scientists say that people eat *at least 50,000 pieces of microplastics a year. It is because when we eat food like fish or drink water, we also take microplastics at the same time. They also say that microplastics are *harmful to *humans, and that many people get *cancer from microplastics.

《ウ》 Now, many people have started to take *action. For example, a young man from *the Netherlands was shocked to see a lot of plastic waste in the ocean. He felt he had to do something. Then, when he was nineteen, he started a *company to clean up the ocean. Many people have become interested and taken part in his work.

So, what should we do in our *daily lives to *solve this problem? 《エ》 Some people are starting to change their life styles and trying to reduce plastics. For example, my mother usually carries her own bag when she goes to a store. My father uses his own *spoon and *fork when he eats out. My sister takes her own water bottle to school and doesn't buy water in a plastic bottle. I think we should all follow their examples.

Plastics are *convenient and are used in many places, but they have bad *effects on the environment, animals and humans. We need to take action now! Let's work together for a better future.
